# MINUTES

# BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE EAST SEVIER COUNTY UTILITY DISTRICT

# Thursday, May 16, 2019

The Board of Commissioners of the East Sevier County Utility District met at 5:30 p.m. on Thursday, May 16, 2019, in the Office of The East Sevier County Utility District, 1529 Alpine Drive, Sevierville, TN 37876. Commissioners present were Roy Ivey, President; Barbara Darby, Secretary/Treasurer; and Janice Brooks–Headrick.

President Roy Ivey called the meeting to order at 5:32 p.m. for any old or new business.

A motion to approve the minutes of the April 11, 2019, meeting was made by Barbara; Janice seconded the motion. Motion carried.

A motion to approve the Accounts Payable listing in total as submitted was made by Barbara; Janice seconded the motion. Motion carried.

### Reports

Tony Sneed, Director of Operations for Alliance Water Resources, Inc., went over key points of the financials with the Board. Barbara motioned and Janice seconded the motion to approve Financials. Motion carried.

Tony has been meeting with HOA managers and developers of the subdivisions we provide with sewer service. Our contract with Smoky Mountain Ridge is implied because our signed contract with them cannot be found. We were recently told by the State that they will no longer issue permits to us for any offsite location for which we do not own the sewer system. Our old permits implied that we owned the systems; the State knows we did not declare ownership. Tony has been working with the developers at each site to obtain ownership of the systems.

Barbara asked what exactly we would own. Tony replied that we would own the entire infrastructure, the sewer lines, tanks, the land the WWTP sits on, and the filtration system. Roy said we will have to purchase liability insurance when that takes place.

The State is concerned that there may be a problem if the contract between the District and Alliance is not renewed when it expires in two years so Tony suggested we extend our contract five years. Steve Miller, Developer of Smoky Mountain Ridge, was extremely reluctant to relinquish his ownership, but in time, Tony was able to get him to sign an intent to own agreement. Obtaining ownership of the offsite systems will help the District to grow because we will be able to set the rates and eventually be in a position to service more and more sites.

Tony suggested we install a trailer somewhere off the Mountain for Darrell to shorten his commute and get him closer to the offsite properties.

Tony reported that Alliance had paid out more in repairs in the past fiscal year than agreed upon, and the District owes Alliance \$10,000. The current repair cap is \$29,900, which can be raised to \$39,900. Barbara asked if transactions were documented, and Tony said that Alliance kept an itemized list of all repairs. We could also raise the amount of the cap on the next contract; James said he is in favor of this.

James Ford, Local Manager, submitted his report concerning District operations. One of our employees left on good terms for another job. So far, we have one applicant to interview.

In order to find ways to offer convenience payments for our customers, James has been meeting with First Tennessee Bank. He has a meeting next Wednesday, May 22, to look at some packages they have to offer.

We have made numerous on- and offsite repairs; the One Call Now system has been working well in alerting customers to repairs and water outages before they happen. Janice and Barbara agreed.

### New Business

The Alpine Drive project is going very well; the crew has made it up Alpine in a timely manner. The pressure test they did on the lines went well. Rob the construction manager is doing a fine job. During the winter months, progress on Well C has been slow going but is now picking up. James ordered a green metal roof for our new well-housing building. All the inconveniences have been brief, and everyone is in the loop. Water quality is already starting to improve in certain areas.

Janice asked what we decided about hiring Tommy Turner to do the hydrofracking project at Wells A and B. James said they decided to put that off until Well C improvements are done.

Tony requested signatures for the release of funds for Draws 4 of Loan 2 and Draw 5 of Loan 3 for the Water Storage project.

Janice motioned and Barbara seconded the motion to submit the paperwork for Loan 2, Draw 4 and Loan 3, Draw 5.

The next regular meeting will be held on, Thursday, June 13, 2019, at 5:30 p.m.

RE:	FYE 30 June 2020 Budget Proposal

The District's FYE 2020 budget is respectfully submitted for your review and consideration. The proposed budget covers the District's 2020 fiscal year revenues, expenses and debt service. A rate increase will be required in order to meet our debt service on the USDA Water Project loans closed in June 2019. The rate increase will be a \$5 increase on water availability from \$45/month to \$50/month for residential customers. There will also be a 10% increase to water rates for the commercial flat rate customers.

2020 Revenues -

- <u>Water Sales</u> Growth is projected to remain relatively flat. By means of the rate increase and more accurate usage information from new meters, the proposed water revenue budget for the 2019-2020 fiscal year is an increase of 37% over the 2017-2018 budget.
- <u>Sewer Charges</u> Growth in the number of sewer customers is projected to rise in the offsite developments. With a conservative projected average of 751 customers in the 2019-2020 fiscal year, sewer revenues are projected to rise 18.7%.
- <u>Connection Fees</u> Total connection fee revenue is based on 2 new water customers and 15 new sewer customers, resulting in revenue of \$2,500 for new water connections and \$13,750 for new sewer connections. Total 2019-2020 proposed revenues are equal to the 2018-2019 budgeted revenues due to conservative connection fee estimates.

## 2019-2020 Operating Expenses

- <u>Professional Operations</u> –The cost of providing professional operations services increases 5.21%. Proposed FY2019-2020 expenses include a \$10,000 increase to the Alliance repair budget. This \$10,000 has been removed from the District's repair budget. Proposed professional operations expenses for FY2019-2020 total \$487,824. Without the Repair Budget change, the increase would be 2.6% to cover cost of living increases, insurance increases, and increased supply costs.
- <u>Miscellaneous Expenses</u> Miscellaneous expenses have been reduced 88% due the payoff of the state fine during the 2018-2019 fiscal year.
- <u>Total District Operating Expenses</u> Total operating expenses in FY2019 are budgeted at \$687,149. This amount is 1.2% under the FY2018-2019 budget and includes the Director's fees, payment of the state fine, reconciling bad debts, increased repair budget to maintain District assets, and power costs.

The budget proposal is presented on a cash needs basis. The FYE2020 budget is respectfully submitted for your consideration prior to the start of the District's 2019-2020 fiscal year.

Re: Rate Restructure for the 2019-2020 Fiscal Year

Repayments of the water project loan from USDA must begin in this budget cycle. In order to create a positive net position fiscally, the District must increase water rates. The budget presented tonight includes a \$5 water availability increase to residential customers as well as a 10% increase to commercial customers. This increase is required to maintain good standing between the District and the Tennessee Comptroller's office.

- RE: Alliance Contract Update Proposal

Alliance has managed and operated the District's facilities for the Board since October 9<sup>th</sup> of 2017. We have been pleased with the progress made by the District and look forward to continued improvements in the coming years.

The original contract was written with a three-year term ending September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020.

Alliance Water Resources personnel are in the process of negotiating contracts with the offsite wastewater developments which ESCUD operates. In order to promote stability and a long-term relationship between ESCUD and the District's customers, AWR offers the attached Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) for your consideration.

The MOA does the following:

- Extends the contract between Alliance Water Resources and East Sevier County Utility District for an additional 5-year period.
- Provides for an increase of 5.21%. This increase allows for an additional \$10,000 in the AWR repair limit. That \$10,000 has been removed from the repair line in the District's expense budget.
- Raises the AWR repair spending limit from \$700 per expense to \$1,500.

The draft budget submitted for review has the proposed changes to the Alliance contract incorporated.

The FYE 2019 Budget that is submitted for review will need to be approved no later than June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

## MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

This Memorandum of Agreement has been entered into this <u>13<sup>th</sup></u> day of June, <u>2019</u> by and between the East Sevier County Utility District, (hereinafter referred to as "Utility"), and Alliance Water Resources, Inc., (hereinafter referred to as "Alliance").

This Memorandum of Agreement has as its purpose to modify a Certain Professional Operating Services Agreement dated 12 September 2017 between the East Sevier County Utility District and Alliance.

Pursuant to Section 13.1, the Service Agreement is modified under the following sections:

5.4 In addition, any individual project repair costs in excess of \$1,500 shall be considered extraordinary.

6.1 Utility shall pay Alliance a Base Fee of \$487,824.00 (\$40,652/month) for services rendered as described on the agreement.

The monthly base fee is a fixed monthly base fee and includes a \$39,900.00 Repair Limit and a \$12,200 Chemical Limit as described in the agreement.

9.1 This Agreement shall become effective on  $1^{st}$  day of July, 2019 and shall remain in effect through the  $30^{th}$  day of June 2026, subject to annual appropriation of funds by Utility. If Utility appropriates funds for operation and/or maintenance of the Utility System this Agreement shall remain in force and effect.
