MINUTES

BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE EAST SEVIER COUNTY UTILITY DISTRICT

Thursday, February 14, 2019

The Board of Commissioners of the East Sevier County Utility District met at 5:30 p.m. on Thursday, February 14, 2019, in the Office of The East Sevier County Utility District, 1529 Alpine Drive, Sevierville, TN 37876. Commissioners present were Roy Ivey, President; Barbara Darby, Secretary/Treasurer; and Janice Brooks–Headrick.

President Roy Ivey called the meeting to order at 5:33 p.m. for any old or new business.

A motion to approve the minutes of the January 10, 2019, meeting was made by Janice Brooks-Headrick; Barbara Darby seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Two checks were written after the List of Bills was completed and submitted. Check No. 18558, written to Sevierville Tire & Automotive for \$969.53 and Check No. 18559, written to Selective Insurance Company of America for \$15,000, were added to the list of bills for February after the Financial Packets were delivered to the Commissioners. A motion to approve the Accounts Payable listing plus the additional checks was made by Barbara Darby; Janice Brooks-Headrick seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Reports

James Ford, Local Manager, submitted his report concerning District financials. He went over the list of bills and pointed out that District assets total more than \$1.6m. The available balance in the Operations and Maintenance checking account currently totals \$285,774.82. However, that amount will be reduced considerably due to the insurance payout of \$15,000 and the purchase of inventory to be kept on-hand to prevent delays in repairs because parts are not readily available.

James also reported on operations. He and Darrell Baker, the Wastewater Operator, met with the HOA staff at Bear Creek Crossing to discuss our role in their community. They discussed rates and other topics. James agreed to have Darrell and Brenda, the office clerk, keep a log of septic tanks that are pumped at that subdivision, which will enable the HOA to remind owners that it may be time to have their own septic tanks pumped. This will especially help to prevent overflows during weekends and holidays, when most businesses are closed, making it more difficult to deal with the problem. James will also send our employees out to maintain the pump filters regularly. All went well with the meeting, and the result was a better relationship with HOA staff and a clear-cut performance expectation.

James commented that the past 17 days on the Mountain have been the toughest since he began. There were at least three line breaks. One of the leaks was very difficult to find because it was located at a spot where the ground was giving way next to the creek, allowing the water to escape downward instead of on top of the ground where it would be noticeable. The listening equipment used to locate the leak was ineffective due to the sound of the rushing creek. He noted that Roy and David helped tremendously, and he appreciated it very much. Only two people were without water during that span of over a week. James supplied each with plenty of bottled water and apologized for the situation.

Janice asked if he took pictures when a situation such as that arose to show customers who ask about service interruption. James said that he did.

Our newest employee, Seth Self, is completing a three-day training course through Tennessee Association of Utility Districts (TAUD) so that he can take the test to get his Distribution II license in May 2019.

Our quarterly VOC sample results were successful. We expanded the Well D footprint to the maximum. We replaced a bypass valve at Red Maple Lane. Offsite, several holding tanks were pumped and two pump kits were installed. James said he attended a meeting with Sevier County regarding resort community sewer systems.

Persons to be Heard

Tony Lehman, of 1556 Black Oak Drive, asked how we know when someone new is purchasing property on the Mountain. Barbara said that the previous owner would most likely call to stop service because they want billing to stop. James said the water would then be shut off and locked so that the new owner would need to contact us to begin service. We would require that they fill out an application and submit the required fee and paperwork before service would be restored. Tony mentioned that he was thinking about buying another lot; James told him to be sure to do a title search for any lien that might have been placed on the property. Tony said he would definitely do so.

Old Business

There was no old business to discuss.

New Business

James said that he and Roy have been pricing utility vehicles, and the \$15,000 limit will allow him to purchase a vehicle that will likely need a lot of work. James suggested that the Board raise the dollar limit to \$25,000 and leave the mileage requirement the same. Janice motioned to raise the dollar limit to purchase a used utility vehicle to \$25,000. Barbara seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The Well C project has begun. The large metal tank there has been dismantled and hauled away. James has been to Knoxville meeting with Mark Jendrek, ESCUD's attorney; McGill Engineers; and Kirk Morris from the USDA, which has created a positive situation for our upcoming projects. James just received a package with contracts that he will take to Mark Jendrek tomorrow to look over. James can then get

them signed and distributed in order to expedite the project. Kirk has been out of work due to the 30-day government shutdown. He has a backlog of work to concentrate on, which hopefully will not delay our project. We will just have to roll with the punches to get everyone on the mountain quality water.

January's safety meeting topic was trenching and excavating. The monthly water and wastewater reports were successfully submitted to the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC).

The next regular meeting will be held on, Thursday, March 14, 2019, at 5:30 p.m.

Adjournment

Roy Ivey moved, and Barbara Darby seconded, a motion to adjourn at 6 p.m. Motion carried.

FOR VALUE RECEIVED, East Sevier County Utility District of Sevier County, Tennessee hereby acknowledges itself to owe and for value received hereby promises to pay to the registered owner hereof the sum of \$\sum_{5,169.23}\$ on or before **November 14, 2020**, together with interest at the rate of **2.875%** per annum until paid, such interest being payable at maturity. Both principal hereof and interest hereon are payable in lawful money of the United States of America by electronic fund transfer or by check or draft mailed to the registered owner at the address shown on the registration book. Upon final payment, this certificate shall be submitted to the Registrar for cancellation.

This certificate, together with such notes as may be issued, is one of a series in an authorized aggregate principal amount of up to \$266,000, issued by the District, for the purpose of providing funds to finance water and sewer system improvements and extensions, pending the issuance of Water and Sewer Revenue Bond (the "Bond") authorized by resolution of the Board of Commissioners of the District on September 12, 2017 which the United States of America has agreed to purchase.

This certificate is transferable by the registered holder hereof, or by its attorney duly authorized in writing, on the registration books of the District, at the office of the Secretary of the District, as Registrar, and the notation of such transfer and registration by the Registrar on the registration books. All assignees shall take this certificate subject to such condition. The District may treat the registered owner as the absolute owner hereof for all purposes, and shall not be affected by any notice to the contrary whether or not any payments due on this certificate shall be overdue.

It is hereby certified and recited that all acts, conditions and things required by the constitution and by the laws of the State of Tennessee to exist, or to be done precedent to and in the issuance of this obligation, do exist, and have been properly done, happened, and been performed in regular and due form and time as required by law; and that provision has been made to pay the principal and interest thereon as same falls due.

This certificate and the income therefrom are exempt from all present state, county and municipal taxes in Tennessee except (a) Tennessee excise taxes on interest on the Certificate during the period the Certificate is held or beneficially owned by any organization or entity, other than a general partnership or sole proprietorship, doing business in the State of Tennessee, and (b) Tennessee franchise taxes by reason of the inclusion of the book value of the Certificate in the Tennessee franchise tax base of any organization or entity, other than a general partnership or sole proprietorship, doing business in the State of Tennessee.

This certificate is subject to prepayment prior to maturity at the option of the District, in whole or in part, at any time at the principal amount thereof and accrued interest to the date of prepayment.

This certificate is a special obligation of the District, payable from the proceeds of the above-described bond and from the net revenues of the water and sewer system of the District.
