MINUTES

BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE EAST SEVIER COUNTY UTILITY DISTRICT

Thursday, April 11, 2019

The Board of Commissioners of the East Sevier County Utility District met at 5:30 p.m. on Thursday, April 11, 2019, in the Office of The East Sevier County Utility District, 1529 Alpine Drive, Sevierville, TN 37876. Commissioners present were Roy Ivey, President; Barbara Darby, Secretary/Treasurer; and Janice Brooks—Headrick.

President Roy Ivey called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. for any old or new business.

A motion to approve the minutes of the March 14, 2019, meeting was made by Barbara; Janice seconded the motion. Motion carried.

A motion to approve the Accounts Payable listing in total as submitted was made by Barbara; Janice seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Reports

Evan Romo, District Manager for Alliance Water Resources, Inc., went over key points of the financials with the Board. Barbara motioned and Janice seconded the motion to approve Financials. Motion carried.

James Ford, Local Manager, submitted his report concerning District operations. We created an Excel spreadsheet for Bear Creek Crossing Property Owners' Association to show which properties have had their septic tanks pumped within the last couple of years. The Property Owners' Association members had requested the list at their last meeting with ESCUD. The Alpine project is going well. Jan asked if the leak on Alpine that was detected earlier in the day had been fixed. James said that with Roy's and David's help the leak has been repaired already.

James also reported that since the last meeting staff has replaced a pump at Sherwood Forest, replaced a low-voltage relay at Well D, successfully flushed the Well C footprint, and repaired roads at Douglas Lake Resort. Staff worked well with contractors on the sewer installation project. The concrete pour at Well C is complete and the Alpine Drive water main relay is going as planned.

March's safety meeting covered a focus on safe driving. Monthly water and wastewater reports were successfully submitted to TDEC. The large amount of rainfall in the area

has caused many on- and offsite problems that the staff has responded to admirably. Numerous leak repairs were made on the Mountain.

Persons to be Heard

Steve Bradley, President of English Mountain Property Owners' Association (EMPOA), reported that the sewer line on Aintree, where a mudslide had occurred last month, exposing the line, might have pulled apart. There is a sewage odor coming from that area, and Steve can smell it from his home on Hollyberry. He said that one customer, which he declined to name, has been complaining about the odor and has threatened to call the state. James commented that he believes the problem is occurring only when the pump kicks on and that he will investigate to see what can be done to alleviate the problem.

Steve said a large part of the contention between a portion of the customers and the District is a lack of communication and offered to relay any information concerning operations to the customers at the EMPOA meetings, which are held every six months. James asked if he could let them know that the improvement projects are going as planned.

Evan mentioned that the water quality and frequent line breaks are the biggest complaints given by customers. Having the One Call Now communication system in placed has helped to bridge the communication gap. He suggested that Steve mention this service to the attendees and instruct them to call the ESCUD office if they would like to be added to the call list.

Tommy Turner of WNC Hydrofracking spoke about the process of well fracking in anticipation of being hired by the Utility to frack Wells A & B. Hydrofracking, or hydraulic fracturing, is a well stimulation technique in which rock is fractured by a pressurized liquid. The process involves the high-pressure injection of 'fracking fluid' (primarily water, containing sand or other proppants suspended with the aid of thickening agents) into a wellbore to create cracks in the deep-rock formations through which water will flow more freely. When the hydraulic pressure is removed from the well, small grains of hydraulic fracturing proppants (either sand or aluminum oxide) hold the fractures open, enabling the well to perform more efficiently.

Evan asked how long the process takes. Tommy said it normally takes 2-3 days but could take longer under certain circumstances. Roy asked about a 24-hour follow-up performance test. Tommy would perform this test. Barbara asked what his success rate is. Tommy said his success rate is 90 percent. Evan asked about the depth of the wells, which Roy said are about 600-700 feet deep. Tommy asked how wide the well opening is; Roy said it is 6-8 inches wide. Tommy suggested the Utility contract for only one well at first to see how effective it would be. Roy commented that at the very least, they would learn what was down there. James said that the total output for all the wells right now is about 45,000 gallons per day.

Evan asked about cost, and Tommy replied the job would cost between \$15,000 and \$20,000 for both wells. James said that he would like to have the wells performing better, which would be a great help when we are having supply issues. Evan said he is interested and would speak to Attorney Mark Jendrek. Jan asked if Well C was up and running now; James told her it was.

Old Business

There was no old business to discuss.

New Business

Evan said that the paperwork for the new sewer line for the backwash at Well C has been signed by the USDA and Attorney Mark Jendrek. James met with Aqua Clear to discuss the installation of the filter at Well C and said that everyone is on the same page.

Evan presented paperwork for the release of funds for Loan 3, Draw 4, totaling \$25,250 to pay for the sewer line at well C. Janice motioned and Barbara seconded the motion to release the funds for Loan 3, Draw 4, totaling \$25,250. Motion carried. The document was signed by Barbara and Roy.

The icemaker in the office has broken; James found one at home depot for \$750. Adding a five-year extended warranty and tax, the cost would be around \$1,000. James will double-check the length of the warranty before making a purchase. Jan asked if they deliver and install it. James said neither would be necessary; he would be able to do that himself. Barbara motioned to purchase an icemaker at a cost not to exceed \$1,100. Jan seconded the motion. Motion carried.

A discussion ensued concerning Clyde's purchasing the ESCUD truck he has been driving for \$400. Evan said that according to Mark Jendrek, bids do not have to be taken for any item with a sale price that low. Roy asked about the truck that blew up on the way to the repair shop. An employee of the shop had offered to purchase it for \$400 but never paid the money. The truck is still at the shop. James said that in time he hopes to have a dependable fleet of vehicles. He said the recent purchase of the ATV was a great idea; it is used often on some of the rougher roads that most likely would cause much more wear and tear on the pick-ups. Roy asked how many Rangers we have now. James said that we have one Ranger that runs well and the Alliance vehicle. The rest are not running well.

Barbara said she will be out of town the day of the next meeting and asked if we could possibly move the meeting to another day. All agreed to meet on Thursday, May 16, at the regular time of 5:30. Brenda is to post the change at the office windows and in the newspaper notice.

The next regular meeting will be held on, Thursday, May 16, 2019, at 5:30 p.m.

Both principal hereof and interest hereon are payable in lawful money of the United States of America by electronic fund transfer or by check or draft mailed to the registered owner at the address shown on the registration book. Upon final payment, this certificate shall be submitted to the Registrar for cancellation.

This certificate, together with such notes as may be issued, is one of a series in an authorized aggregate principal amount of up to \$291,000, issued by the District, for the purpose of providing funds to finance improvements and extensions to the System, pending the issuance of Water and Sewer Revenue Bond (the "Bond") authorized by resolution of the Board of Commissioners of the District on September 12, 2017 which the United States of America has agreed to purchase.

This certificate is transferable by the registered holder hereof, or by its attorney duly authorized in writing, on the registration books of the District, at the office of the Secretary of the District, as Registrar, and the notation of such transfer and registration by the Registrar on the registration books. All assignees shall take this certificate subject to such condition. The District may treat the registered owner as the absolute owner hereof for all purposes, and shall not be affected by any notice to the contrary whether or not any payments due on this certificate shall be overdue.

It is hereby certified and recited that all acts, conditions and things required by the constitution and by the laws of the State of Tennessee to exist, or to be done precedent to and in the issuance of this obligation, do exist, and have been properly done, happened, and been performed in regular and due form and time as required by law; and that provision has been made to pay the principal and interest thereon as same falls due.

This certificate and the income therefrom are exempt from all present state, county and municipal taxes in Tennessee except (a) Tennessee excise taxes on interest on the Certificate during the period the Certificate is held or beneficially owned by any organization or entity, other than a general partnership or sole proprietorship, doing business in the State of Tennessee, and (b) Tennessee franchise taxes by reason of the inclusion of the book value of the Certificate in the Tennessee franchise tax base of any organization or entity, other than a general partnership or sole proprietorship, doing business in the State of Tennessee.

This certificate is subject to prepayment prior to maturity at the option of the District, in whole or in part, at any time at the principal amount thereof and accrued interest to the date of prepayment.

This certificate is a special obligation of the District, payable from the proceeds of the above-described bond and from the net revenues of the water and sewer system of the District.
